Advanced Technical Theatre Productions

This course is designed to extend and deepen the knowledge developed in the Technical Theatre Productions course. Working alongside each mainstage production, students will hone their previously learned skills of design by leading in different production areas. A focus will be placed on industry-standard applications of design such as technical drawing, Vector Works, lighting plots and rigging, and sound mixing and design. Through collaboration with multiple departments, students will also develop and utilize their leadership and communication skills through the different roles in the theatre. They will have opportunities to lead design and manage different productions not only in the theatre department, but also in collaboration with the other performing arts concentrations and ceremonies within the school. This course will follow Project Based Learning and Inquiry-Based Learning guidelines. Each student will be assessed through their leadership roles, collaborative projects, and self-evaluations.
